



Safety tips :

Transporting and trailering your (rental) boat

1. Always make sure the boats are tightened and well-secured on the trailers with straps. Check if the trailer is properly hooked on the towbar, and use the security cable.
2. Mind your speed limit. And drive very slowly on the gravel-roads, to prevent damage to the boats, engines or trailers !
3. For rental boats :When driving with the boat on the trailer, always place the engine in the vertical stand. Put the electric engine horizontal, and secure it. See image 1 .
4. For rental boats : When launching the boat, or taking it out at the trailer ramp, tilt the engine. See image 2 .
5. For rental boats : Be carefull not to drive the trailer-lights into the water, they are NOT water proof. See image 3.
6. When driving, make sure there is no loose equipment that can fall out of the boat, and hit other cars or people.
7. Don't drink alcohol if you need to drive a car, or use a boat on the water. It is a criminal offence, Sweden has a zero-tolerance policy.
8. After launching your boat, please park your car and trailer in a decent way, so that others are able to use the ramp trailer also.
9. If your boat has a manual drain plug, don't forget to check if it is tightened before launching the boat
10. Don't leave the boat/trailer unattended or unlocked in unsafe places or at night, and remove expensive equipment like fishfinders.

11. For rental boats : Charging batteries : Boats equipped with sonar and/or electric engines need to be charged at night. Connect the charger in the right way and set it to the right position with the "mode" button (sailing boat), see image 4

Remember, usage of rental boats and trailers is fully at your own risk. We advice you to keep the rules in mind, it can save you from personal injuries and a very expensive trip go safe, and have fun in Dalsland !
